



Cedar Tree Uniform Closet

The Uniform Closet is a collection of gently used school uniforms donated or traded by Cedar Tree families located in the back room of the office building.

Who can use the Uniform Closet?

The closet is self-serve for all Cedar Tree families during school hours. A parent must accompany students.

What are the advantages to using the Uniform Closet?

Quality donations help families save money and simplify shopping.

How does it work?

To donate:

- Put laundered, gently worn uniform items in the large bin by the closet.
- The volunteer coordinator will place acceptable items in the closet.
- We will dispose of unacceptable items.
- Keep track of the number of items you donate until you are ready to trade.

To shop:

- Items are \$5 apiece. Or you may trade one item for every item donated.
- While shopping, return discarded items back to their labeled bins.
- Make payments online via [e~Funds](#) or pay in the office.

Note:

- Parent volunteers manage the Uniform Closet. Please leave the closet in as good or better shape than when you found it.
- You can take home items to try on. Simply return unused clothing to the proper bin or pay for items kept.
- Donated items should meet current uniform standards and be in good condition – no stains, rips, patches, holes, missing buttons, etc.
