



Cedar Tree Uniform Closet

The Uniform Closet is a collection of gently used school uniforms donated or traded by Cedar Tree families located in the back room of the office building.

Who can use the Uniform Closet?

The closet is self-serve for all Cedar Tree families during school hours. A parent must accompany students.

What are the advantages to using the Uniform Closet?

Quality uniform donations help families save money and simplify shopping.

How does it work?

To donate:

- Put laundered, gently worn uniform items in the donation bin by the closet.
- The volunteer coordinator will put acceptable items in the closet, and dispose of unacceptable items.
- Keep track of the number of items you donate until you are ready to trade.
- Donated items should meet current uniform standards and be in good condition-not faded or frayed, no stains, rips, patches, holes, missing buttons, etc.

To shop:

- Items are \$5 each, or you may trade one item for every item donated.
- Make payments online via [Campus Parent](#) School Store or pay cash, check, or card in the office.
- You can take items home to try on. Simply return unused clothing to the proper bin or pay for items kept.
- Please leave it in as good or better shape than when you found it.
